Hello My Friends! It seems that Christmas and the New Year celebrations were only a short time ago, yet Lent will soon be upon us. Lent is the time period between Ash Wednesday and Easter Sunday set aside for self-reflection and preparation to meet our risen Lord. While some will use this time period for the self-denial of some frivolous thing, I encourage you instead to spend personal time in prayer, study, devotions or worship before our Easter morning celebration. Let us meet our risen Lord with clean hearts and new devotion in ministry.

Living in our nation and world today is a major concern to a growing number of people. Our nation remains divided, wars continue across the globe, and many people live without hope in their lives. At times our burdens may seem overwhelming. Jesus in Matthew 11: 28-29 offers us this hope for rest.

*“Come to me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light.” (NRSV)*

As the scripture indicates, Jesus recognizes that in life, we may will feel exhausted, burdened, and in need of necessary rest. “Take the yoke” means to become a disciple, learn, and be in connection to Jesus. His “yoke is easy” because it is designed to fit our needs and His expectations from us are light.

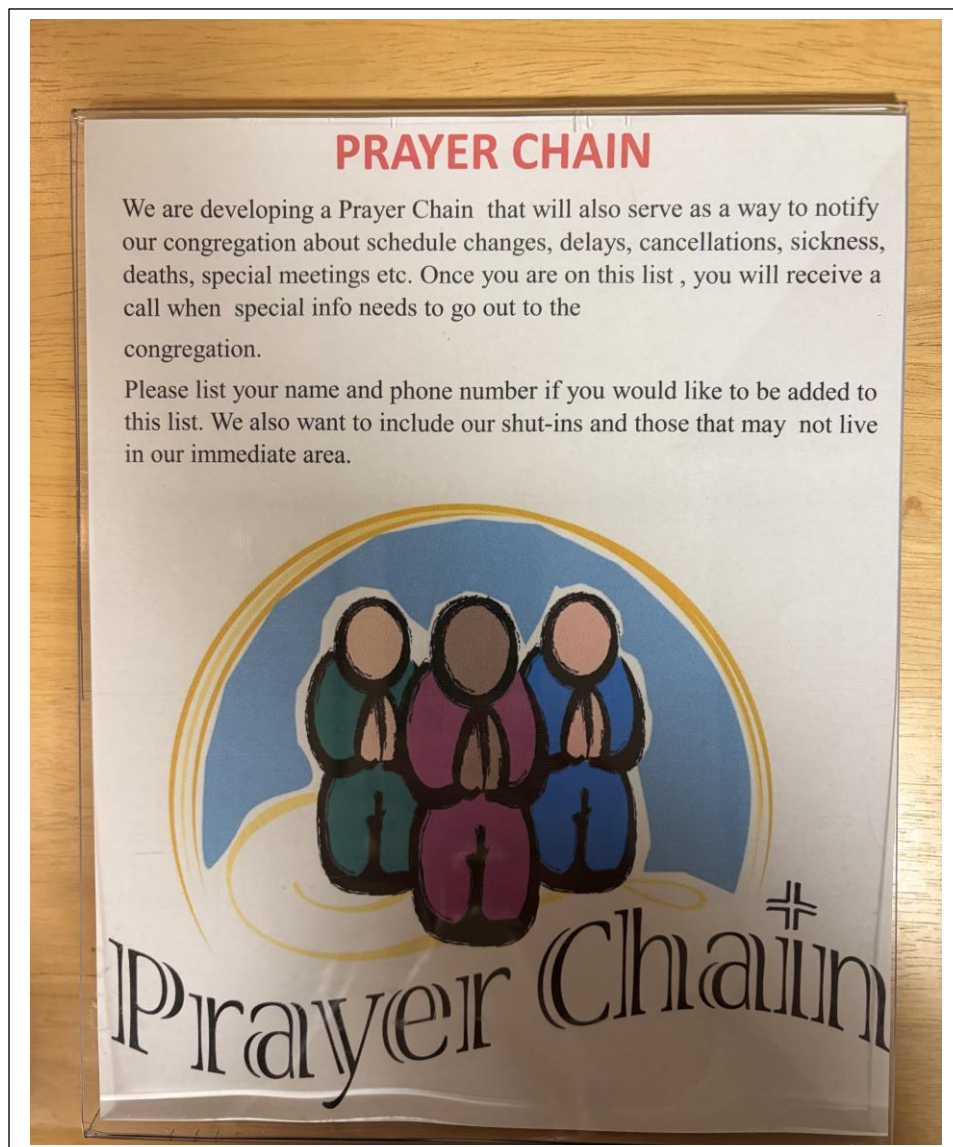
