



#### PIE SALES

Missions will be selling Blueberry, Cherry and Apple pies on Saturday, October 11th after the 4:00 church service as well as on Sunday, October 12th after church. For example, if you buy two pies you are essentially buying a pair of shoes for a student at the school.

#### **CLARA BOLEN SHOE PROJECT**

We are in the middle of the Missions Shoe Project for students at Clara Bolen Elementary. Once the Shoe Project form is filled out, a \$20 voucher is issued to the student and then the parent and child use the voucher to purchase a pair of shoes from our local Walmart.

#### **OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD PROJECT**

In the Gathering space, is a table with the Operation Christmas Child (OCC) boxes. Inside each box are two sheets 1) Shoebox Gift Suggestions sheet for a girl or boy-PLEASE read the flier as it tells what IS and IS NOT acceptable and there have been some new changes 2) "Let's Be Friends" sheet, an optional information sheet you can fill out to share a little about yourself for the OCC box recipient. Inside

you can fill out to share a little about yourself for the OCC box recipient. Inside the box is the GIRL/BOY label and 3-rubber bands. Please take an OCC box home, decide if your gift will be for a boy or girl and check the age range, fill the

box with items from the list for either a girl or boy, cut the label out and tape it to the outside of the box, and place the three rubber bands around the outside of the box.

Missions will be covering the cost of the shipping of the boxes, but if you choose to make the payment for shipping, please make a check out to Samaritan's Purse and place the check or money in the enclosed OCC envelope and put it on top of the contents inside the OCC box. OCC boxes MUST be returned to the church by Sunday, NOVEMBER 16th!
