Merry Christmas! Welcome to Advent, the time of preparation for the coming of the Christ Child. Christmas can be magical, exciting, and a time of great celebration. As Christians, we anticipate celebrating the arrival of God's Son, Jesus Christ. How are you preparing to receive the baby Jesus during this time of Advent?

The common themes of Advent are hope, joy, peace and love. But, in our world today, these values can be illusive, temporary, or short lived. Where can we find everlasting hope, joy, peace and love in this life? The prophet Isaiah shared this promise from God in Isaiah 9: 6-7,

"For a child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counsellor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace. His authority shall grow continually, and there shall be endless peace." (NRSV)

This prophesy will be fulfilled at two different times. The first fulfillment came with the birth of Jesus. 
